- **Indian Self-Determination Act: Law & Administration;
October 23-25, 2017**

This is the most comprehensive training available anywhere in Indian Country on the Indian Self-Determination Act. This course is everything you ever needed to know about the Indian Self-Determination Act. U.S. Congress passed Pub. L. 93-638 over 40 years ago, but most tribes and federal agencies do not have a good understanding of the Act. As a result, tribes are not fully exercising their rights under the Act. Learn about tribal rights directly from the national expert who was involved in developing the regulations and federal policy on the Indian Self-Determination Act.

- **Indirect Cost Principles: Contract Support Costs;

Tribal council members and board of directors will receive training on their roles and responsibilities, fundamentals of Indian law, constitutional principles, separation of powers doctrine, tribal sovereignty, legal basics and implications, leadership and supervision, budget formulation and execution, and conflict resolution, among many other related topics.
